You must be enrolled full-time during the term for which you are receiving funding. The Department of Psychology will work with the Office of Student Financial Aid to verify need for applicants of this scholarship.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY: To be considered for this research scholarship, a student must:

- 1. Be a declared psychology major
- 2. Have completed at least 30 credit hours (including 9 hours in psychology) prior to due date of application
- 3. Have completed at least one semester at Ohio State prior to due date of application
- 4. Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.7 or higher
- 5. Demonstrate financial need (please note that the department will work with the Office of Financial Aid to verify student financial need).
