

PSYCHOLOGY EDUCATION ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

FOR UNDERGRADUATE PSYCHOLOGY MAJORS

Education abroad scholarships of \$2,500 are available to be awarded to psychology majors to facilitate involvement in OSU-approved credit-bearing education abroad programs that will enrich a student's psychology education. Please see educationabroad.osu.edu for a list of eligible programs. Please note: this scholarship is not eligible for use toward any non-credit bearing programs listed on the Education Abroad website. To be eligible, students must be a declared psychology major for at least two semesters and have an overall GPA of at least 3.0. Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the student through Student Financial Aid. Please note that students participating in the Psychology and Culture in Europe Program are not eligible for these funds. The Psychology Department heavily subsidizes the Psychology and Culture in Europe Program and therefore students are not eligible for additional funds from the department for this program.

As part of the application, students must submit a 700-1000 word essay describing what they hope to gain from this education abroad experience. As part of the review process, the committee will pay close attention to the justification for how the education abroad experience will enhance the applicant's education in psychology.

If you are awarded a study abroad scholarship, the funds will be released for processing after the Office of International Affairs (OIA) confirms your enrollment in the education program. This scholarship award is contingent upon completion of the education abroad experience. If you do not attend the experience and scholarship funds have been disbursed, repayment of the funds is expected by the end of the disbursement term.

For study-abroad programs beginning January 1st – April 30th, the application deadline is December 1st.

For study abroad programs beginning May 1st – August 31st, the application deadline is April 1st.

For study-abroad programs beginning September 1st – December 31st, the application deadline is June 1st.
